Thank you for enquiring about a membership at Beaumaris Bowls Club. We are very proud of our club and its history. Our club has one Tiff grass green and one synthetic green, allowing year round bowling.

A variety of Memberships are on offer. Free coaching is available for both newcomers to bowls and established players.



CLUB HISTORY

In the early 1950s, a number of local citizens decided to form a lawn bowls club in Beaumaris. Following discussions with the then City of Sandringham, approval was given for the club to lease land in the F.L. Yott Reserve and establish a Bowling Club. Considerable hard work was involved in setting up the club and its green and in 1955 it became affiliated with the RVBA, and in 1957 with the VLBA.

From its humble beginnings of a tin shed and one green, the club has evolved over the years to now offer 2 excellent quality greens with a magnificent clubhouse. The greens have been given consistently high ratings year after year.

As the Club grew in numbers and in bowling experience, it became well established within the two associations. The Club was selected to host the International "Jack High" series from 1981 to 1985 and has been a premier Melbourne lawn bowls venue ever since, hosting a range of high profile events.

The Club has just refurbished its Tiff green and renovated its clubhouse bar, making its facilities the envy of local area clubs, and a venue of choice for local community functions.



MEMBER CATEGORIES

Criteria applicable to all membership categories unless otherwise specified:

- Covered under Club's liquor license - no need to sign in
- In Members' Friday Evening Draw (must be at club during draw) and receive newsletters
- Green Fees to be paid when bowling in Pennant and/or attending club organised Social events
- Coaching support available to all bowling members
- A free club shirt is given to **new** bowling members on payment of their membership fee

Any category can upgrade to a higher category during the year (a pro-rata fee will apply)
